Worker Thank You Barbecue: 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM – Bring a salad or dessert to share - hamburgers, chips and sodas provided. Bring your family!
The Barbecue Picnic Area is on the west side of the park across a large lawn from the Senior Center. We suggest you park by the Senior Center and walk over to the BBQ.

Volunteer Training: 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM - A chance for new **control workers** to learn how to work a time control, start or finish, and for experienced workers to brush up their skills and help teach the new folks.

Captains Meeting: 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM - A chance for **control captains** to get prepped for the rally and pick up some equipment. Comm Captains are encouraged to attend!

Details: The Worker Thanks BBQ, the control worker training and the captains meeting are on the same day, in the same location. ***Please RSVP to your Captain if you will attend the picnic and/or the training.***

Where: Arcadia Park, 405 S. Santa Anita Ave., Arcadia, (626) 821-4619.

Directions - Take the 210 Freeway to the city of Arcadia (about four miles west of the intersection of the 605 freeway with the 210).

Offramp: Santa Anita Avenue, turn south. In half a mile you will pass East Huntington Drive and then the park will be on your right (west). Enter the first parking lot you come to and park as close to the building and bowling greens as possible.

For the picnic, you will need to walk a ways due west across the lawns to the "Barbeque Picnic Area" (which is next to W. Huntington Drive). There is some parking at this area if you prefer not to walk across the lawns - accessible from W. Huntington Drive. Look for barbeque grills and a bathroom building.

The **Worker Training** and **Captains' Meeting** are in the Community Room, which is the large center room in the Senior Center, a one-story building that is part of the Bowling Green complex. This building is just north of the bowling greens (and east of the swimming pool complex).
