



Rim of the World Rally Volunteer Training Session 2006

What: A chance for new **control workers** to learn how to work a rally start, finish, or arrival time control – and for experienced workers to brush up their skills and help teach the new folks.

Details: Both the control worker training and the Worker Thanks BBQ are on the same day, in the same location. ***Please RSVP to your Control Captain if you will attend the training.***

Worker Thank You Barbecue: 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM –

Bring a salad or dessert to share - hamburgers, chips and sodas provided. Bring your family! You do not need to RSVP – just show up and enjoy!

The Barbecue Picnic Area is on the west side of the park across a large lawn from the Senior Center. We suggest you park by the Senior Center and walk over.

Control Workers Training: 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM -

Where: Arcadia Park Senior Center, 405 S. Santa Anita Ave., Arcadia, (626) 821-4619, inside the "Community Room." Note that the Senior Center is part of the Bowling Green building complex and is located on the north side of the lawn bowling greens (and east of the swimming complex).

Directions - Take the 210 Freeway to the city of Arcadia (about four miles west of the intersection of the 605 freeway with the 210).

Offramp: Santa Anita Avenue, turn south. In half a mile you will pass East Huntington Drive and then the park will be on your right (west). Enter the first parking lot you come to and park as close to the building and bowling greens as possible. For the picnic, you will need to walk a ways due west across the lawns to the "Barbeque Picnic Area" (which is next to W. Huntington Drive). There is some parking at this area if you prefer not to walk across the lawns - accessible from W. Huntington Drive. The Worker Training is in the Community Room, which is the large center room in the Senior Center, a one-story building.
